Red text is for notes on specific actions, this generally is used for but not limited to typed messages, laughter, and pauses.

Blue text is for my personal notes. This is generally small comments I have to say about something such as corrections or confirmations. Also used for small thoughts I had that don't hold much importance.

Ken: Okay, hey guys, what's up? Uh... Ken here, I'm standing in for the President uh, this week because she couldn't be here. Um, so I'm a go over presidential news. Um... Not gonna lie, I-I don't really have any presidential news. Now I'm gonna move to Vice President. Not gonna lie, I don't really have any vice presidential news. Ummm... That-that's what it is.

Jolee: Hey, can you hear the uh, the request form?

Pause

Ken: Oh yeah, forgot. Uh, we have a complaint form, if you need to complain against anyone, let me know, as VP.
